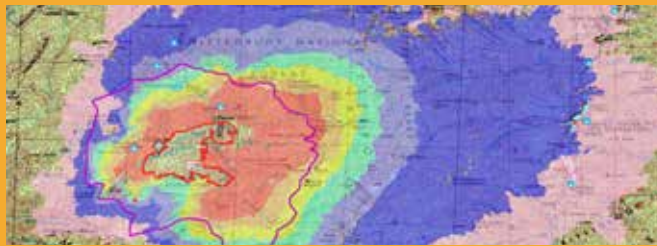


Wildfire Decision Support

What We Do

We can:

Run Fire Behavior Predictions (Short-Term, Near-Term, and FSPro)

Complete analysis of Season-Ending events, spread events, and fuels

Assess potential impacts to Highly Valued Resources and Assets such as infrastructure, natural resources, or designated areas

Assist with all elements of publishing good WFDSS decisions

Troubleshoot fire applications

Find on-site assistance as needed (analysts, strategic planners, technical specialists).
