- Emerging Issues- none
- WFDSS O&M
 - Critical infrastructure changes for upgrading to Window 2016 should be completed this week. We are in the process of testing Training and Prod, please send any issues found into feedback, like always so we can track and fix
 - FAMAuth on hold while other critical work is completed including the Oracle 12c RAC License, Windows 2016 upgrade, and IRWIN v6.0 integration.
 - IRWIN V6 testing this week (Jan. 13th)
 - Oracle RAC licenses upgraded to 12c completed in November
 - Known Issues and resolution
 - Fires since 1/1 have not been updated. This will be done once other critical work is completed. Anticipate the end of January to early February
 - Spatial Inventory of STFB is calculating incorrectly.
 - MODIS/VIIRS the service is in the process of being migrated, and once it's available it will be back available in WFDSS. We have a banner posted in WFDSS that directs the users to the NASA site where heat detection info can be retrieved.
 - Active Planning areas and some kite markers are not displaying on the intelligence map. This happened as

part of the Oracle 12c work and developers are working on a fix.

- Four known issues are planned to be fixed in the next release, , March 6th.
- WFDSS Next Gen, a new WFDSS that will replace our current versionwork just started and will take time.
 - Sam Amato will be Product Owner, Erin Noonan and Tonja Opperman are deputy Product Owners.
 - Next Gen is starting from the ground up and will not just be moving buttons, we will be using a business analyst and user interface designer to assist with this. Next Gen will be built using an agile process which allows for quick and nimble changes. User groups and feedback will be important to this process to take feedback and adjust.
 - Input/feedback will be desired from the field/GAEs. Please start thinking about who in your areas might be best suited to provide feedback/suggestions toward this effort.

Spatial Data:

- Agency contacts can be found on the WFDSS homepage > Data > Geospatial team contacts. If you don't see who you think you should get with Andrew Bailey. BOR has submitted shapes (previously they did not have)
- In the past we have made 53 updates, this year we are expecting similar. We know the FMU/Shape schedule has not been updated yet on the website, will be soon.
 - Looking to do 6 updates to the SO/FMU this year, next one due to agency leads by Feb 5thth RDA must have from agency leads by Feb. 12th and will be in WFDSS by 26th.
 - Data refresh plan- will be updated on website soon, it will be roughly similar to the previous year. For layers that haven't experienced large changes are looking to reduce this workload to focus on Next Gen efforts.

IRWIN

- Version 6 testing is occurring this week. Morgan and Andrew are working to ensure WFDSS meets V6 expectations. The IRWIN release is scheduled for March 9. The majority of the updates/changes are related to resources with
 - In V6 WFDSS will have same permissions as other applications for incident acres, previously had lower authority than CADs
 - WFDSS will grey out many of the field on the info screen when the incident is marked as Certified. Though users can still edit/update info as usually until the fire is out (nothing is changing with regard to implications of out date).
 - WFDSS added feature to allow for addressing WFDSS created incidents that are marked as quarantined. A National Editor will need to assist the WFDSS user to get it out of quarantine.
