Reminders

GAE Calendar

• We have moved the calendar from Firenet Google to O365 (access from Homepage, under Hot picks Right Hand menu). We post the training dates sent to Morgan/Rick and planned outages and reboots (6/9 Prod reboots 0300-0400, Training 2200-2300) (6/12 WIMS reboots 00:30-01:30, no FB models during this time).

Granting User Roles:

- After giving a user role on Prod, it can take up to 30 minutes for that role to appear on Training (the utility to sync roles runs every 30 minutes). If a user needs a role on Training right away (for example if they are sitting in a Training course) grant the role in Prod and Training to avoid having to wait 30 minutes.
- When giving a user role on Prod, if the user adjusts their profile on Training before the new role syncs to Training, the roles won't sync. Users adjusting their profile in Training prevents the sync utility from working correctly.
- If you suspect a role hasn't synced correctly for a user, let us know through Feedback and we can investigate.

IRWIN Updates

- WFDSS has remained connected with IRWIN version 6 since March 9th, connection is stable.
- o Saw duplicates that resulted from a "tier 4" unit in Mississippi needing to coordinate with their "tier 3" dispatch center for resource ordering. Please reach out to the IROC helpdesk if you foresee this problem coming up. If you create a fire in Firecode or WildCAD, you should not need to re-create it in IROC. IROC can transfer incidents between dispatch centers. If you have WFDSS work in two incidents that are supposed to be one record in WFDSS, it becomes very difficult to de-duplicate.
- o Continued need for training at the local unit, there are non-Wildfire incidents being created as wildfire incidents and it is being pushed into WFDSS these are more severity, COVID support, or other codes being created that really shouldn't be in WFDSS. If it isn't a wildfire, please have it created as a non wildfires incident type-category.
