WFDSS Quick Tip – Morgan and Rick

- Periodic Assessments- what it takes to make them stop.
 - o Periodic Assessments stop when an incident has an Out Date
 - Check if decision is not out for approval (locking it from receiving updates from IRWIN, including the out date).
 - If a decision is out for approval it has to be approved or rejected
 - If the plan is to reject and the approver is not available, an owner can and someone as a reviewer and the reviewer can reject it.
 - Incident needs to be marked "Out" which for most incidents comes from CAD, but can come from other sources including WFDSS. Note CAD has a higher ADS than WFDSS and can overwrite values entered by WFDSS.

o If the incident is already in the fire reporting or the certified state then the Out Date will need to come from Informs.

WFDSS O&M Status/Update – Morgan Pence and Rick Mowery

- Our Project Manager is working with FAMIM to obtain Risk Based Decision documentation to support Classic WFDSS not taking on upgrades and infrastructure changes as the current plan is to sunset the application in approx. 1 year, and before fire season 2023.
- As a result we are currently planning for a release November 10th that focuses on higher priority bugs that impacted front end users this fire season and some behind the scenes clean up items.
- We are still working on loading AK landfire data, it is currently being reviewed in our lower environments.
- We are tentatively planning to continue general bug fix releases through the winter/spring on an 8 week cycle.

Geospatial Data –

- Refresh- we are using a BLM resource to assist in getting caught up on refresh plan from 2021. Currently being worked is: USFS Trails, Fuel Treatments, campgrounds. Up next is: BLM buildings, Transmission lines, electric substations, and power plants
- FMU/SO Update: There is one more chance to update yet this year. Data is due to your agency lead by 11/3, and will be available in WFDSS 11/17.
- Rick Mowery and Morgan Pence are now the contacts for the agency GIS leads to send FMU/SO updates to. We have notified the agency GIS leads.
- We will be working on the FMU/SO update schedule and Refresh Plan for 2022 soon.

IRWIN Status – Morgan and Rick

Unknown yet what changes are coming in the next iteration of IRWIN.

WFDSS Next Gen Update –Wes Hall

- Currently Go live date is end of October 2022. Right now we are working on the map, search functions, and then Relative Risk and FSPro. Will continue work on spatial fire planning. We may not have Basic, STFB, NTFB in the initial release.
- SO/FMU shapes/direction loaded to Classic WFDSS will be used as snap shot to
 preload the spatial fire planning service, ergo if you have units that have changes
 they want/need to make they should go ahead and do so, it will not be a waste of
 time to update them in Classic.
- Next Gen will rely on services for many of the functions, for example most of the
 data layers will be pulled in through services which will ensure the data is pulled
 from the source and kept current to their efforts, and the models will also function as
 a service.
- We have not begun to work out yet the transition details for how to manage incidents that overlap the transition timeframes.

IFTDSS- Kim Ernstrom

- FTEM Season is off and running things are working smoothly so far. - IFTDSS Team working on a lot of backend development moving the application to a new Cloud Service
- IFTDSS Team working on building online training modules in the NWCG Wildland Fire Learning Portal to be released this winter: "How to use IFTDSS for your Burn Plan"
- IFTDSS Storymap coming soon! Highlighting primary functionality and some case studies on how the system is being utilized in the field across a variety of projects NEPA, Treatment Prioritization, Burn plans.
